## About the Presenter

Craig R. Scott is author of *'Lost Pensions': Settled Accounts of the Act of 6 April 1838* and *Records of the Accounting Officers of the Department of the Treasury, Inventory 14 (Revised)*. He has co-authored several books relating to records in Northern Virginia and written articles published in *National Genealogical Society Quarterly*, *Family Chronicle* and many other genealogical publications.

A professional genealogical and historical researcher for more than 23 years, Scott specializes in the records of the National Archives, especially those that relate to the military. He is a former Clan Scott Genealogist (1985-2000), recent governor-at-large of the Virginia Genealogical Society, and faculty member of the Institute of Genealogy and Historical Research, Samford University.

Scott is a member of Military Historians and coordinated the 2007 Advanced Military Records Course about the French and Indian War, Revolutionary war and War of 1812. He serves on the editorial board of the *National Genealogical Society Quarterly* and is a director of the Association of Professional Genealogists.

He lives in Westminster, Maryland, where he is CEO of a genealogical publishing firm.
